RECOMMENDATION:

It is requested that Council approve a change in scope for the HDR/Devine Tarbell Associates contract for the FERC Project 176 license.

DISCUSSION

In October 2009, the Council approved \$200,000 for the Historical Properties Management Plan (HPMP) portion of the FERC Project 176 license. Since that time, the City of Escondido and the Vista Irrigation district have decided to pursue a Conduit Exemption rather than a full license from FERC. HDR/DTA will assist us in working through the federal agencies and the public notification process to complete the application for a Conduit Exemption. This change in direction provides a change in scope for the HDR/DTA contract as we will not be pursuing the HPMP at this time. This is a change in scope only, with no financial impact.
