Brindle) <br> This project includes miscellaneous cleanup amendments to the Downtown <br> Specific Plan as initiated by the City Council on 10-28-09, Changes are necessary <br> to correct a recently discovered mapping error that splits a building at 333 E. <br> Grand. The re-evaluation of permitted uses in the Retail Core is necessary to <br> address a potential legal challenge because some miscellaneous assembly uses <br> are permitted where churches are not. The amendment would also address <br> murals, setbacks for monument signs, and other design and land use issues as <br> recommended by the Design Committee of the Downtown Business Association. <br> The Planning Commission will consider this item on 2/9/10. |
