SUBJECT:

Implement 2-Hour Parking on Escondido Boulevard between Eighth Avenue and Ninth

Avenue

RECOMMENDATION:

It is requested that Council adopt Resolution No. 2010-73 implementing 2-Hour parking on both sides of South Escondido Boulevard between Eighth and Ninth Avenue.

FISCAL ANALYSIS:

Funds are available in the streets budget for the sign installation.

PREVIOUS ACTION:

Transportation and Community Safety Commission (TCSC) recommended approval at their April 8, 2010, meeting.

BACKGROUND:

The business owner submitted a request signed by 86% of the business owners asking if street spaces along both sides of Escondido Boulevard can be included in the 2-hour parking zone area. There seem to be some residents of Escondido using the parking spaces fronting the businesses for all day unrestricted parking similar to a "Park and Ride" situation and then using the rapid bus from the nearby bus stop to commute to San Diego. This is not a beneficial use of limited parking where parking demand is high. Elderly customers have ceased to visit the businesses anymore as the distance to walk there from other nearby parking is too far for them. The item was discussed and recommended for approval at the TCSC meeting on April 8, 2010.



RESOLUTION NO. 2010-73

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ESCONDIDO, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE TRAFFIC SCHEDULES FOR TIME ZONE PARKING

WHEREAS, Section 28-5 (7) of the Escondido Municipal Code provides that the City Council shall establish a Traffic Schedule for on-street time parking zones; and

WHEREAS, this City Council desires at this time and deems it to be in the best public interest to amend said Traffic Schedules; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Escondido, California, as follows:

- 1. That the above recitations are true.
- 2. That the Traffic Parking Schedules for On-Street Time Parking Zones be amended to include as follows:
