Funds are available in the streets budget for the sign installation.


PREVIOUS ACTION:

Transportation and Community Safety Commission recommended approval at their April 8, 2010, meeting.


BACKGROUND:

The business owner submitted a request to the City asking if street spaces along the west side of Maple Street can also be included in the 2-hour parking time zone area. In its present use, it can become a "Park and Ride", which is not a beneficial use of the limited amount of downtown parking where parking demand is high. Four parking spaces fronting the Bed and Breakfast are the only spaces that do not have limited time parking within this parking area. The item was discussed and recommended for approval at the Transportation & Community Safety Commission meeting on April 8, 2010.

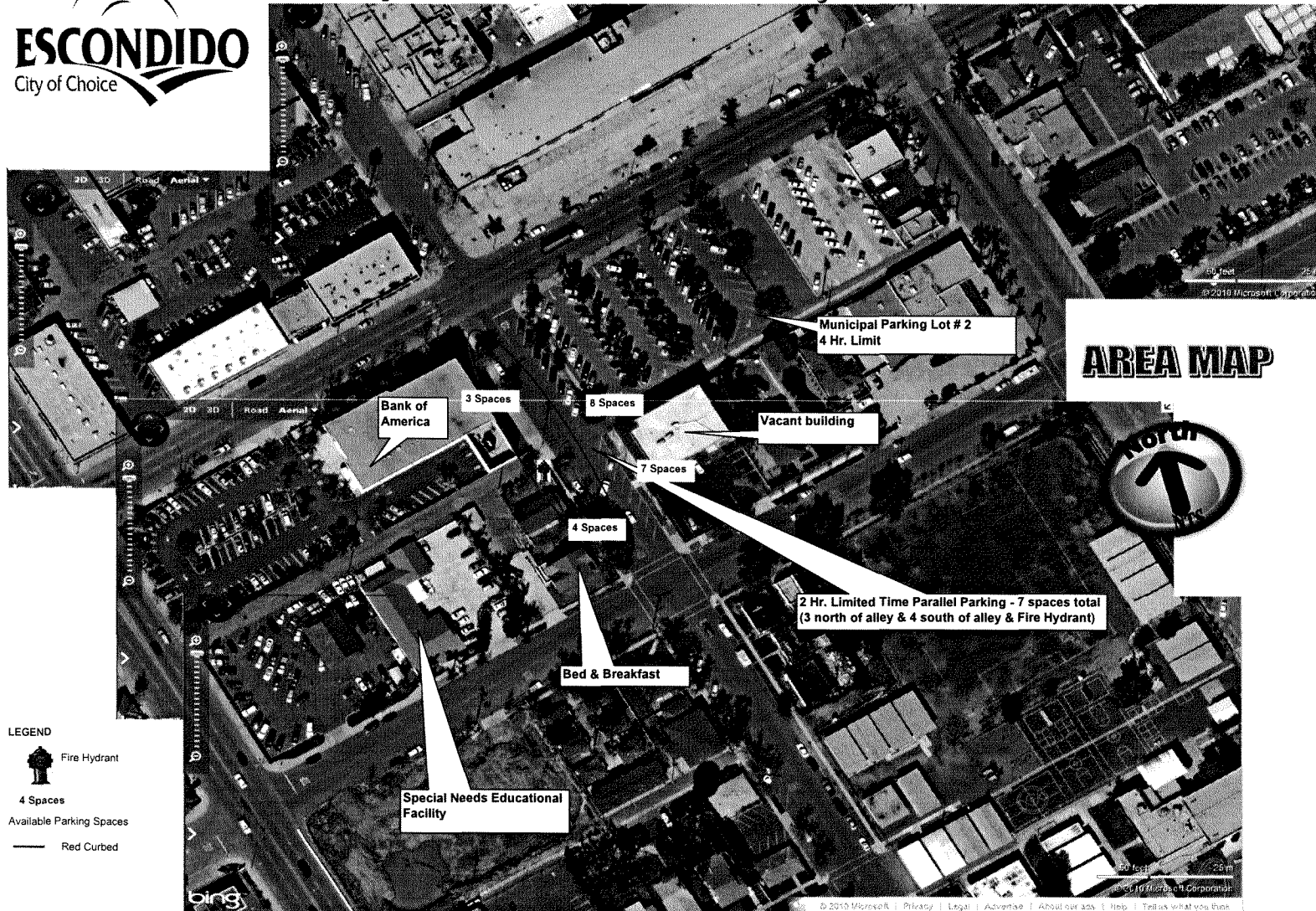

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-72

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF ESCONDIDO, CALIFORNIA,
AMENDING THE TRAFFIC SCHEDULES FOR
TIME ZONE PARKING

WHEREAS, Section 28-5 (7) of the Escondido Municipal Code provides that the City Council shall establish a Traffic Schedule for on-street time parking zones; and

WHEREAS, this City Council desires at this time and deems it to be in the best public interest to amend said Traffic Schedules; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Escondido, California, as follows:

1. That the above recitations are true.
2. That the Traffic Parking Schedules for On-Street Time Parking Zones be amended to include as follows:
