2	2010 Treasurer's Report, First Quarters (K. Hugins) According to the City's Investment Policy, the City Treasurer is required to submit an investment report to the Council for review on a quarterly basis. The report, as required by Government Code Section 53601, will include the type of investment, issuer, date of maturity, par, and dollar amount invested, and market value for each security held by the City.

2	Authorization to Purchase New Asphalt Patch Truck (R. O'Donnell)
3	This crucial piece of equipment is due for replacement and plays a key role in maintaining City streets in a safe condition. Gas tax funds, accumulated from project savings, will be used to purchase this vehicle.
	First Amendment to the Hotel Economic Development Incentive Agreement for Springhill Suites in La Terraza (2007-18-PD) (B. Redlitz)
4	The hotel was approved by Council on 12/12/07 and has not been constructed yet. The agreement specifies that in return for economic incentives granted by the City, the hotel must be open and generating transient occupancy tax by 4/1/10. due to the economic downturn and difficulty securing construction financing, the applicant is requesting a three-year extension of the date to 4/1/2013 by which he has to commence operations.

5	City of Escondido Landscape Maintenance District — Public Hearing (F. Schmitz) As part of the approval process for the annual Engineer's Report for the City of Escondido Landscape Maintenance District, a public hearing is required to be held to receive public input on the proposed assessments for the upcoming fiscal year. 	Specific Plan Amendment (PHG 09-0032) Palos Vista Specific Plan (B. Redlitz)
6	An Amendment to the Specific Plan is required since wireless facilities are not a listed use within the open space areas of the Palos Vista Specific Plan. The proposed amendment would be specific to this request only, and would not add general language to the existing Specific Plan to allow other wireless communication facilities as a permitted or conditionally permitted use.

Due to tighter lender underwriting requirements, increased financing costs, and a desire to maintain the original high quality designand size of the project, the developer is experiencing a \$500,000 shortfall with leveraged financing.
