PUBLIC HEARINGS

15. MODIFICATION TO PLANNING CONDITION NO. 24 FOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (2004-66-CUP) — A modification to Planning Condition No. 24 for the Talk of the Town car wash project (2004-66-CUP) to allow the required masonry separation wall to be constructed in one of three potential locations. The zoning code requires the wall to be constructed on the applicant's property line at the bottom of an adjacent slope. The proposed modification would allow two potential alternatives to permit placement of the wall at or near the top of the adjacent slope. One proposed alternative would allow the applicant to enter into an agreement with approximately nine individual homeowners to pay the cost for the homeowners to construct the

wall at the top of the slope on their properties. The other alternative would allow the applicant to enter into an agreement with the New Traditions HOA to pay the cost for the HOA to construct the wall at or near the top of the slope on HOA property. (File No. 0800-40 2004-66-CUP)

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-156R

Bill Martin, Planning Department, gave the staff report and presented a series of slides.

Mayor Pfeiler opened the public hearing and asked if anyone would like to speak on this issue in any way.

Linda Bailey, Escondido, indicated the developer was willing to pay for the wall and the homeowers would use their own contractor to construct the wall.

Munther Ghazal, Applicant, listed the improvements to be made by the project and indicated he would work with the homeowners' requests.

Mark Lawrence, Escondido, stated the homeowners would like the wall constructed from the applicant's property.

Kimber Allison, Escondido, presented a series of slides and requested the wall be built at the top of the slope.

Roger Fannin, Escondido, asked Council to delete the HOA from the proposal.

Kyle Kruger, Attorney, voiced concern with transient problems and urged Council to require the wall be built at the top of the slope.

Lisa Prazeau, Escondido, presented a series of slides and stated she did not support a car wash at the site.

Laurie Poole, Attorney, requested the HOA not be included in the proposal, and that all agreements would be with the individual property owners.

M.A. Mareck, Escondido, stated that a democratic government should have integrity.

Mayor Pfeiler asked if anyone else wanted to speak on this issue in any way. No one asked to be heard. Therefore, she closed the public hearing.

MOTION: Moved by Councilmember Daniels and seconded by Councilmember Abed to approve Resolution 2010-156R, removing references to the HOA. Motion carried unanimously.
